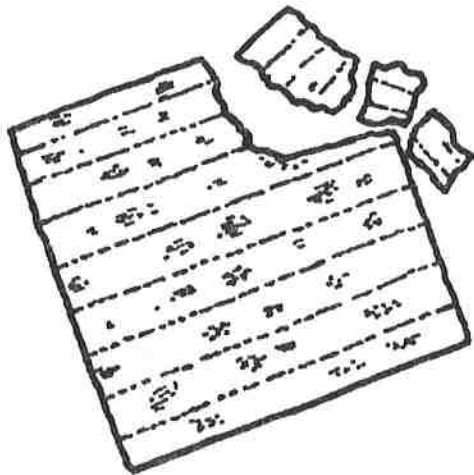
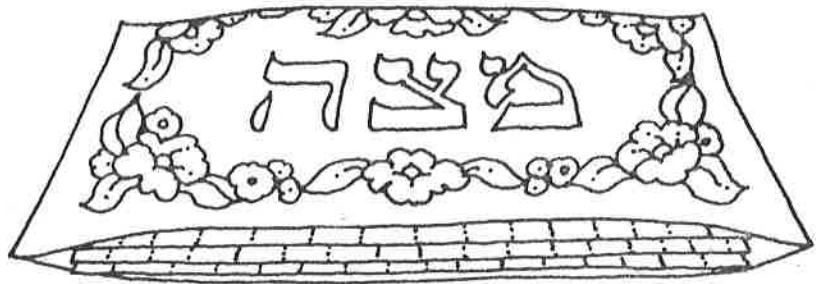

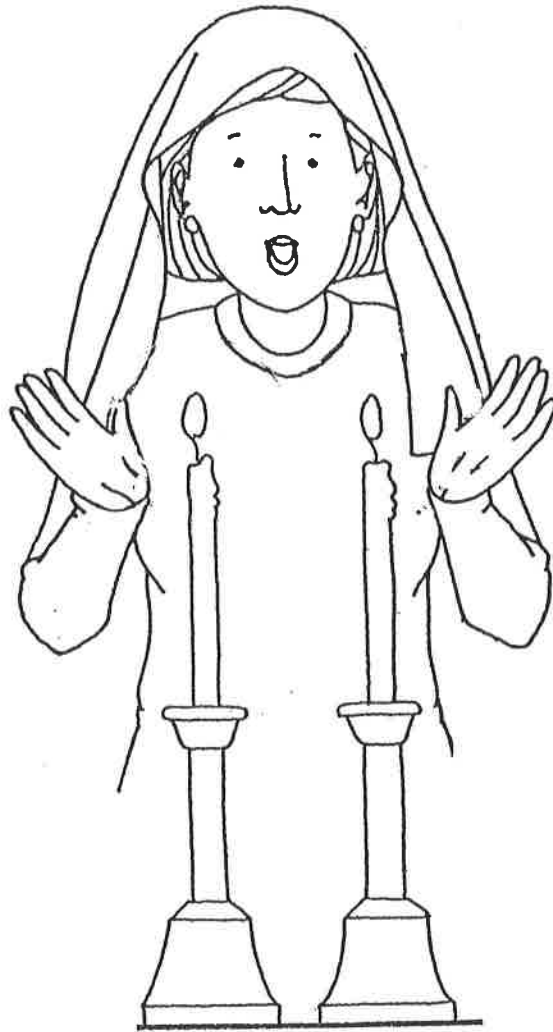

Then of course there’s me!!!

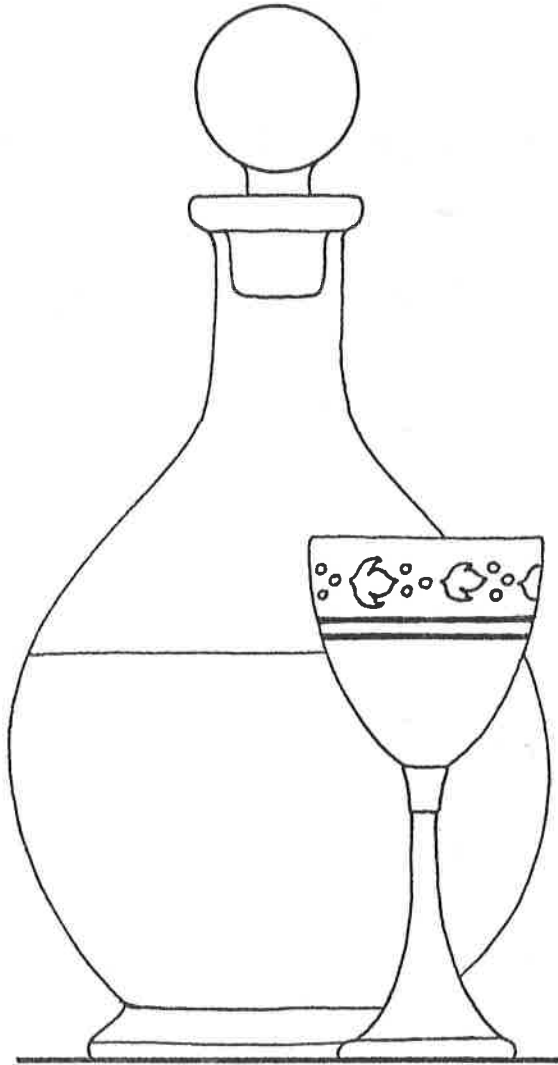
Tune: Oh Do You Know the Muffin Man

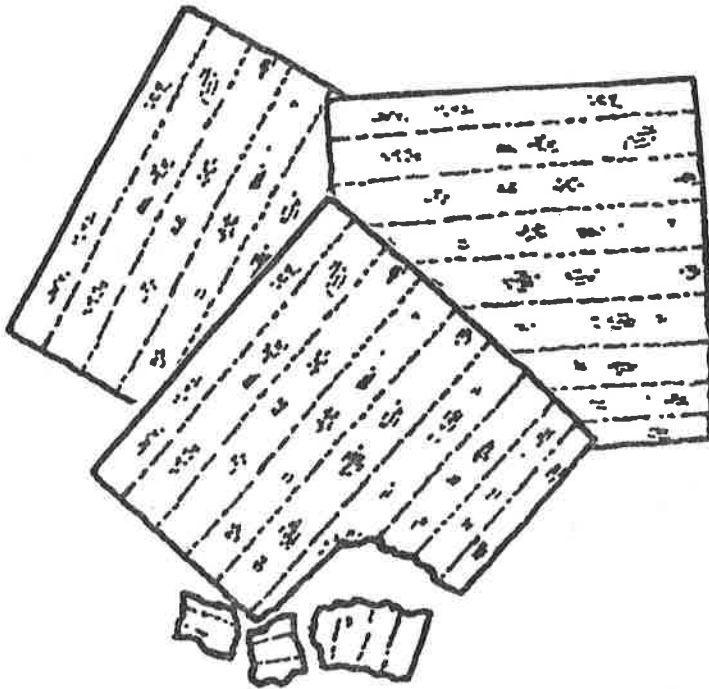

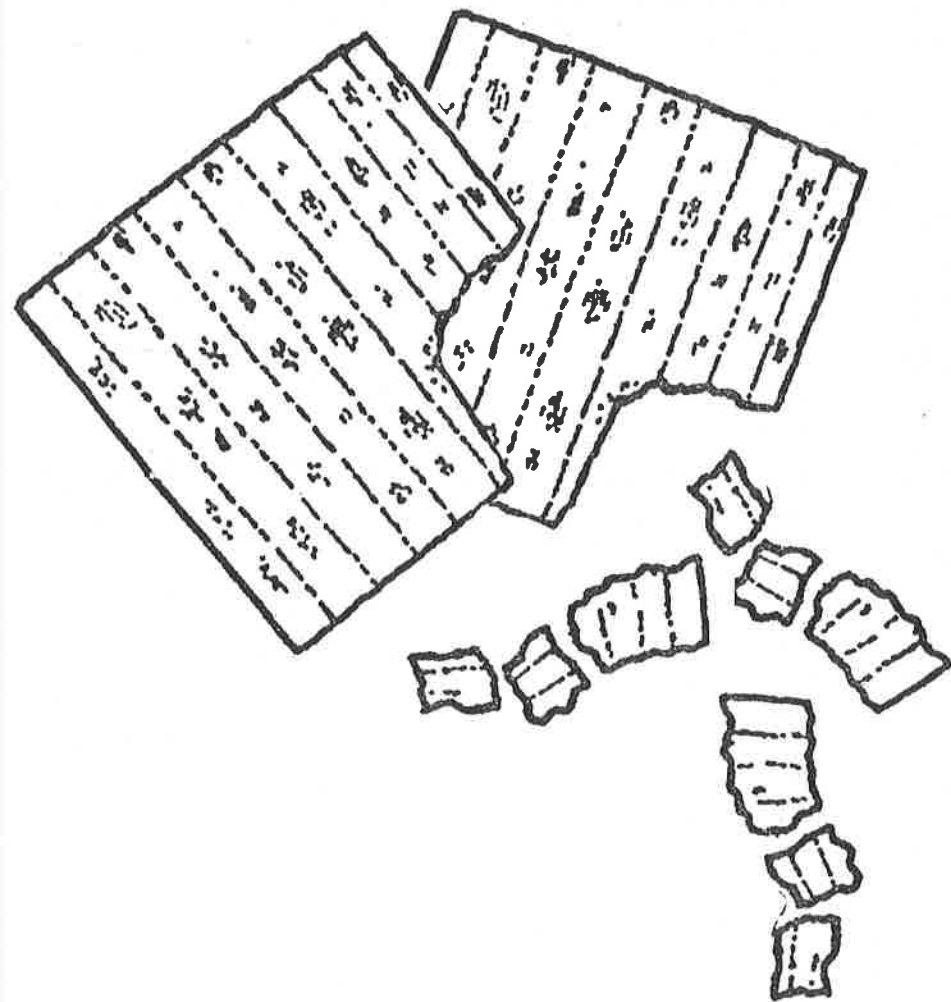


We eat special foods on Pesach---

Let's pretend to make matzah.

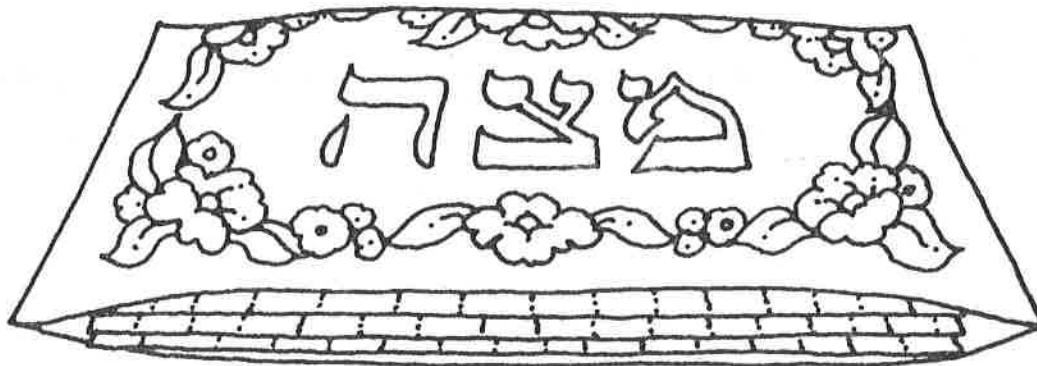

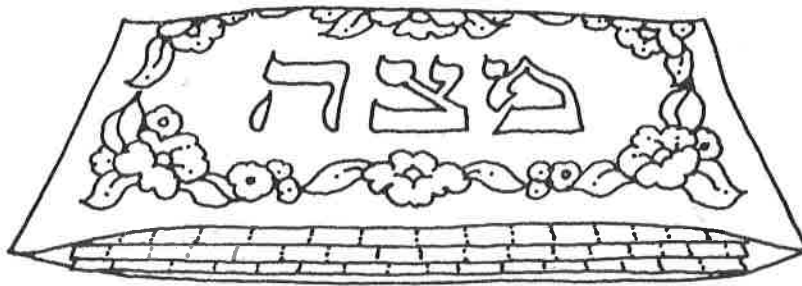

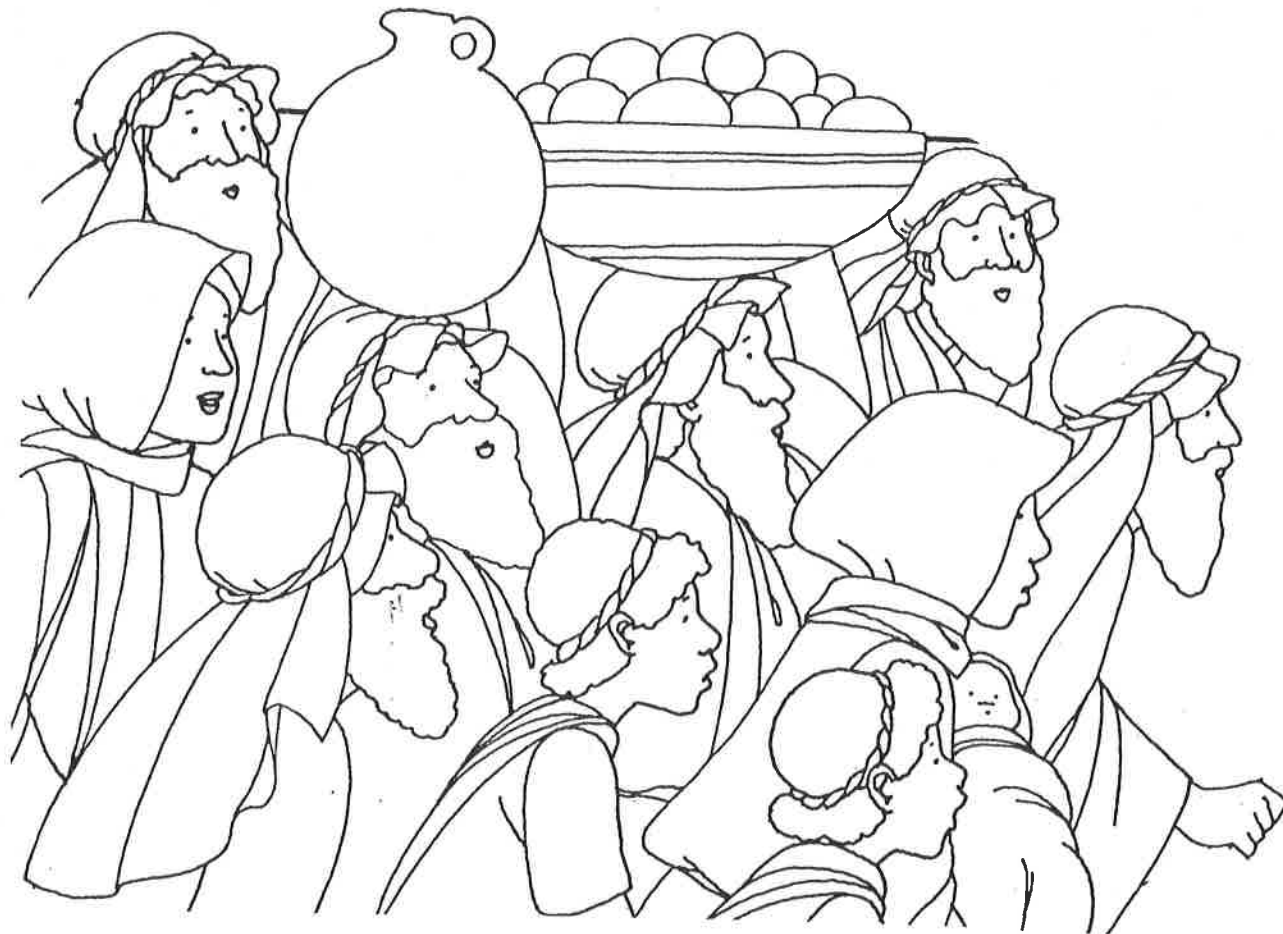
